City of Austin Road Construction.

Several streets in our area (Balcones Club Drive, Brookwood Cove, Topridge, and Scotland Well) are scheduled for Overlay Construction. This construction involves grinding up the existing asphalt and base material, removing it, and applying new



pavement. Prior to construction, notices will be left at homes informing people to not park on the street. Any cars left on the street will be towed to another location. The timing of these projects is not known at this time.

183 Mobility Project

Major construction for 2025 includes

- Completion of 11 outside widening bridges from Pond Springs Rd. to Great Hills Trail,
- Construction of roughly 13 miles of outside widenings on NB and SB US 183 between Lake Creek Pkwy. and MoPac, and
- Completion of the direct connector structure between the new express lanes on US 183 and the existing express lanes on MoPac.

Old Lampasas Dam Project

- Over 10,000 cubic yards of rock material to date have been transported for reuse in various City facilities and projects.
- A temporary cofferdam has been installed to keep the project site dry during excavation.
- Excavation for the dam as well as the principal and auxiliary spillways will continue through the end of the month.

Your HOA Has Been Busy

Wonder what members of the HOA Board were doing last month?

We noticed a City proposal to require trash bins to be placed outside bike lanes and contacted Council Member Laine's office suggesting this could pose a problem for streets like Spicewood Parkway. The staff member agreed and forwarded the concern to the appropriate person. It is much easier to address this situation before implementation.

The Architectural Control Committee met with several homeowners to discuss construction and renovation plans and bring them in line with deed restrictions. This committee also monitored homes for sale and alerted the brokers to the deed restrictions.

We planned the Neighborhood Garage sale with input from participants. We advertised, posted street signs, included helpful hints on the website, as well as creating a map of participants in formats that could be printed to hand out or downloaded on a phone.

HOA members, who paid dues and were identified in the Oak Wilt outbreak as needing to treat their trees, received modest checks to help offset the treatment expenses.
