

Texas Senate Bill 491 is set for vote in Senate Rules Committee on Monday, March 27.

Texas House Bill 2198 is set for vote in House Land and Resources Committee on Wednesday, March 29.

Senator Bryan Hughes (Tyler/Texarkana area) and Representative Cole Hefner (Sulphur Springs/Mount Pleasant area) filed companion bills that will <u>override</u> <u>existing city zoning</u> by removing building height restrictions in cities with populations over 725,000, which include Houston, San Antonio, Dallas, Austin, and Ft. Worth. Neither man represents any of these cities.

These bills will end zoned height limits and allow construction of taller buildings near single-family homes. The wording of the bills specifies that compatibility rules, which extend to 500 feet in residential areas (Austin), would change to within 50 feet of the proposed project.



With the growth in the Texas population, many

cities, both large and small, struggle with new development styles. Each city has its own blend of traditions and ways of proceeding into the future. It is only through local cooperation that all the people can plan a way to move forward.

Regardless of our views on how development should proceed, it is important that the people affected have a voice. <u>These state laws will remove a community's</u> <u>ability to chart its own future.</u>

Each bill is in a committee where it either will be passed on to the Senate or House for vote, returned to the author, or shelved.
