Old Lampasas Dam Project

The City of Austin plans a reconstruction of the small dam located off Old Lampasas Trail and across from the PEC substation. It is not visible from the street, but does prevent flooding to several homes, as well as roads and downstream improvements. Construction is planned to start in 2024 and projected to take 16 months.

Recently the City named two potential staging areas for materials and supplies parkland at corner if Spicewood Springs Road and Old Lampasas Trail and a site at Spicewood Springs Road and Wexford Drive.
